2017 CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP

Open to all members, spouses and dependents 21 years old and below in good standing.

ENTRY FEE - P 500.00

REGISTRATION:

- Each entrant must register by filling up the Entry Form, which will be available at the Registration Counter.
- Only participants with a signed Entry Form will be given flight assignments for Rounds 1 and 2.

Eligibility:

- All participants in the Club Championship must be members, spouses or dependents in good standing.
- The January 2017 handicap index from the South Course will be used as the basis for classification. Members without a certified Valley Handicap may only compete in Class
- All dependents who are **21 years old** and below may join the juniors division.

Classifications:

Regular Division

Class A - Index 00.00 to 08.0 Handicap 0 to 9 (Gold Tees)
 Class B - Index 08.1 to 13.9 Handicap 10 to 16 (Blue Tees)
 Class C - Index 14.0 & above Handicap 17& above (Blue Tees)

Seniors Division (55 to 64 years old) Tee off: White Tees- (Open Handicap)

<u>Super Seniors Div.</u> (65 yrs. old and above) Tee off: White Tees –(Open Handicap) (Minimum of 12 participants. If there are less than 12, all participants will compete in the Seniors Division).

<u>Ladies Division</u>

Tee off: Red Tees - (Open Handicap)

(Minimum of 12 participants).

Junior Division

Tee off: Boys Blue Tees/

Girls - Red Tees – (Open Handicap)

(Minimum of 12 participants).

To reach the minimum number of twelve (12) players the Committee reserves the right to change the format.

Any seniors joining the regular division shall tee off from the Gold tee if in Class A and Blue tees if in Classes B or C.

- All participants must compete in only one division/class. Participants 55 yrears old and above must declare whether they would compete in the Regular or the Seniors Division prior to the first elimination round. In the absence of any declaration, they will be classified under the Regular Division based on his handicap index on the South Course.
- Participants should qualify in their own Class, based on the handicap indices. Players belonging to a lower class bracket may opt to compete in a higher class bracket, (e.g. a Class "B" player may want to compete in Class "A") provided he signifies his intention before the start of the elimination round one (1).
- A total of 16 top qualifiers per class will be eligible for the match/play "knockout" process. If a class has less than 16 qualifiers but more than eight (8), the general numerical draw for 16 qualifiers will be used. Top players will be bye on the first round.
- 2016 winners must join the Qualifying Round to determine their position in the Match Play Round.
- Elimination rounds and the subsequent match play rounds will be played at the South Course by players from Class A, B, C Seniors, Ladies divisions. The Juniors Division elimination rounds and the subsequent match play rounds will be played at the North Course.

TOURNAMENT FORMAT:

Qualifying Round

Registered participants will play **Round 1** on February 5, 2017 (Sunday). They will be given flight assignments by the Tournament Committee and will tee-off sequentially.

Round 2 will be played on February 12, 2017 (Sunday).

Top sixteen (16) aggregate scores after Round 2 will advance to the Match Play Round. In cases of ties for the sixteenth spot, USGA count back rules will apply.


TIES: For Stroke Play Qualifying: (Round 2 scores will be used).

- The player with a lowest gross score on the last nine holes (10-18)
- If still tied, the player with the lowest gross score on the last six holes (13-18)
- If still tied, the player with the lowest gross score on the last three holes (16-18)
- If still tied, the player with the lowest handicap prevails
- For further ties toss coin.

<u>Match Play Round</u> – All matches may be played at anytime during the scheduled week. In the event BOTH parties do not agree on any schedule during the week, then the OFFICIAL PLAY DATE will be followed. THERE WILL BE NO EXTENSION TO PLAY THE MATCHES AFTER THE OFFICIAL MATCH PLAY DATE.

<u>Tee Times:</u> - No show players will be DISQUALIFIED. However, a player who is late 5 minutes after his/her official tee-off time is ready on the tee, will have a penalty of LOSS OF HOLE on the first hole of the match play. (Rule 6-3). If a player shows up after 5 minutes of his official tee time, he is considered DISQUALIFIED.

Championship match for Regular Division – Class A only:

If the match is "All Square" after 36 holes, a "Sudden Death" play-off starting at Hole. 1 South Course will be held to resolve the tie.

Use of Golf Carts:

Regular, Ladies and Seniors Division participants will be allowed to use motorized golf carts during the tournament. Participants in the Juniors Division are not allowed to ride a golf cart during the tournament. However, Juniors Division participants may avail of the services of caddies.

The 2017 Club Champion, Division Champions, and Runners-up will receive trophies and prizes, as may be determined by the Sports and Games Committee. These prizes will be awarded during the 59th Valley Intra Club awarding ceremonies on Saturday April 1, 2017.
