THE PRESIDENTS' AND DIRECTORS' CUP GOLF TOURNAMENT

DATE : 22 SEPTEMBER 2018 (SATURDAY)

VENUE

JE : SOUTH COURSE (SC) AND NORTH COURSE (NC)

SHOTGUN START : 7:00 A.M. (South Course) 7:30 A.M. (North Course)

ELIGIBILITY: The Tournament is open to all Valley Golf Club Stockholders, Members, Spouses and Dependents in good standing.

CONDITIONS OF PLAY:

FORMAT : MOLAVE STABLEFORD

The following Molave Stableford Points corresponding to the player's NET score will be used:

The Tournament will be conducted in accordance with the Rules of Golf as approved by the USGA and R&A Rules Limited and the existing Local Rules and Tournament Rules of Valley Golf & Country Club.

TEEING GROUND:

BLUE – Regular Division, Jungolf Male (13 to 18 years old)

WHITE – Seniors Division (55 years old and above,); Jungolf Male (12 years old & below; Jungolf Female (13-18 years old)

RED – Ladies Division; Jungolf Female (12 years old below)

Note: Seniors have an option to play in the Regular Division provided they will tee off from the blue tees and their handicap be converted based on the blue tee slope rating. They should declare their classification upon Registration.

HANDICAPS: Handicaps shall be based on the September 2018 of the South and North Courses. For New Members and shareholders without any current VGC Board handicap, their index with other clubs may be used, with possible adjustment from the Tournament Committee but this must be received on or before 16 September 2018. **Maximum handicap for this tournament is 36.**

DIVISIONS: Handicaps will be the basis in determining the Divisions. Composition of players in every division will be finalized as soon as the total number of participants are determined. For the Regular Division and Seniors Division, the top 30% will be classified as Division A, Mid 30% as Division B and the last 30% as Division C. Open Division for the Ladies Division.

Note: In case of ties, players will automatically be elevated to the Higher Division.

PILIGAN: Piligans are mandatory at Php 200.00 per player. Piligans may be used anywhere through 18 holes except on the putting green. A Player may use his 2 shots PILIGAN either in the front or back 9, or in one hole as necessary. All players must declare their intent to their competitor(s) before using their piligan. "PILIGAN" allows the player to choose the better shot between the original & 2nd ball shot.

Upon declaration, a "Piligan" is deemed used even if the original ball was chosen upon taking the "Piligan". Failure to declare the intent to use the "Piligan", the player shall be deemed the second ball in play and shall incur a penalty of stroke and distance.

Piligan raffle prizes presence is not required. For minor raffle prizes presence is required except the top 8 major prizes.

PILIGAN SHOTS ARE NOT ENTITLED TO ANY HOLE IN ONE PRIZE in ALL PAR 3 HOLES. Player can hole out in any nearest hole of all par three for the tournament.

REGISTRATION: Participants must register by signing the Entry Form at the Registration Counter. Entry Fee is <u>P600.00</u>. Members who sign up but do not play shall be charged the entry fee.

TIES will be decided, as follows;

- The player with a lowest net score on the last nine holes (10-18)
- If still tied, the player with the lowest net score on the last six holes (13-18)
- If still tied, the player with the lowest net score on the last three holes (16-18)
- If still tied, the player with the lowest handicap prevails
- For farther ties toss coin

GIMME CIRCLE: If the ball of player is within the "gimme putt circle" but not in the hole, the said player will be allowed to pick up. He is deemed to have holed out in one more stroke to his score.

PICK UP: To speed up play, all players must pick up their ball if they can no longer score a net double bogey for the hole. The marker must put an "X" on the scorecard for the said hole.

WINTER RULES: In case preferred lie or winter rules is declared by the Committee, a player or his caddie should first *mark the position of the golf ball then, lift, clean their ball, then place it as near as possible to its original position, within a maximum of a scorecard lenght, not nearer the hole.* No changing of ball on the fairway and/or greens is allowed.

SCHEDULES: Flight assignments shall be done by the S&G Committee. Pairings will be done in such a away that players within the same division will be grouped together. Flight schedules shall be posted in the bulletin boards no later than September 19, 2018 (Wednesday). It shall be the responsibility of the participant to check his/her tee assignment. Requests for flight assignments will not be entertained.

RULES: The Committee reserves the right to add, change or modify any rule of the tournament. Questions regarding rules shall be referred only to the Rules Committee. Decision of the Rules Committee in all aspects of the Tournament shall be final. The tournament participant hereby willingly agrees and will abide by all Committee decisions.
